The Band Program at Western is among the finest of its kind in Canada. This nationally recognized program has garnered a demand that sees enrollment of 300 students annually, making us the largest program in the City of Calgary. With performance as a focus of the program, we have three large instrumental ensembles (the Grade 10 Concert Band, the Grade 11 Symphonic Band, and the Grade 12 Wind Ensemble) and a Senior Jazz Ensemble. Each ensemble is open to students with previous experience in instrumental music.

Band Program courses are designed to be a co-curricular to our outstanding academic program. Our grade specific performance ensembles are each worth 5-credits and meet twice a week in the AM block. Courses in the AM block schedule make it possible for students to enroll in the Band Program even when they have a full academic timetable. Incoming Grade 10 students may also choose to take advantage of our uniquely offered Band IB stream to fulfill one of their requirements for the IB registration.

Tours

The Band Program travels internationally to participate in workshops at world class institutions such as: UCLA and CSUF, while performing at International Festivals and Disneyland. When remaining in Canada, the Band Program engages in workshops at UBC, UVic and performs regularly at the Whistler Band Festival and Canadian Rocky Mountain Festival. These annual tours provide students with amazing experiences that create memories that they will treasure for a lifetime.
